Children in uniform with hat, packed recess and lunch, returning old learning packs, bringing the new and coming on the day planned. Thank you for your support, it is greatly appreciated. Teachers have invested a great deal of time in the development of the Learning Packs and have an expectation that your children will have a far greater understanding of 'what to do' and 'how to do it' following their day at school. We hope this makes life a little easier at home for you to deliver the home learning. Yes, your child has been told very clearly that they are to do their school work at home!

#### SCHOOL SITE ISSUES

From the perspective of the children returning each day, our endeavours to re-develop the understanding of distancing and hygiene have been significant. Although each day contains many siblings on site, we take the same approach for all kids present in order to minimise confusion and children therefore doing what they see all others doing.

#### Delivering Your Child

The biggest issue to enforce is the directive from DoE that the presence of adults on site is minimal. Last week I highlighted this requirement and now see a need to reiterate.

- Drop and go is preferred! (We have the drop and go zone in Laurie St).
- If entering the site, demonstrate distancing and depart ASAP. AVOID entering bag rooms and classrooms.
- NB Teachers commence playground duty at 8:45am and morning assembly is at 9:10am.

#### Collecting Your Child

End of day is 2:55pm, please arrive as close to this time as possible and socially distance from other parents who may be on site. AVOID entering bag rooms and classrooms.

#### Hygiene

We now have our normal before and after school clean and two high use surface cleans during the day which include play equipment, railings, outdoor furniture, toilet facilities, bubblers, light switches and classroom tables. All classrooms contain sanitiser, soap and paper towel.
