#### **Current Precautions**

- Social distancing of adults on site is essential.
- Bubblers are not available to drink from.
- Cleaning of high touch surfaces occurs throughout the day.
- Hand washing and sanitiser used when entering classrooms in the morning, after recess and lunch.
- Toilets contain liquid soap and paper towel.
- No contact sports eg soccer and bullrush.
- No events for parent gathering eg assemblies and sports carnivals.
- No inter-school competitions eg sport, debating and dance.
